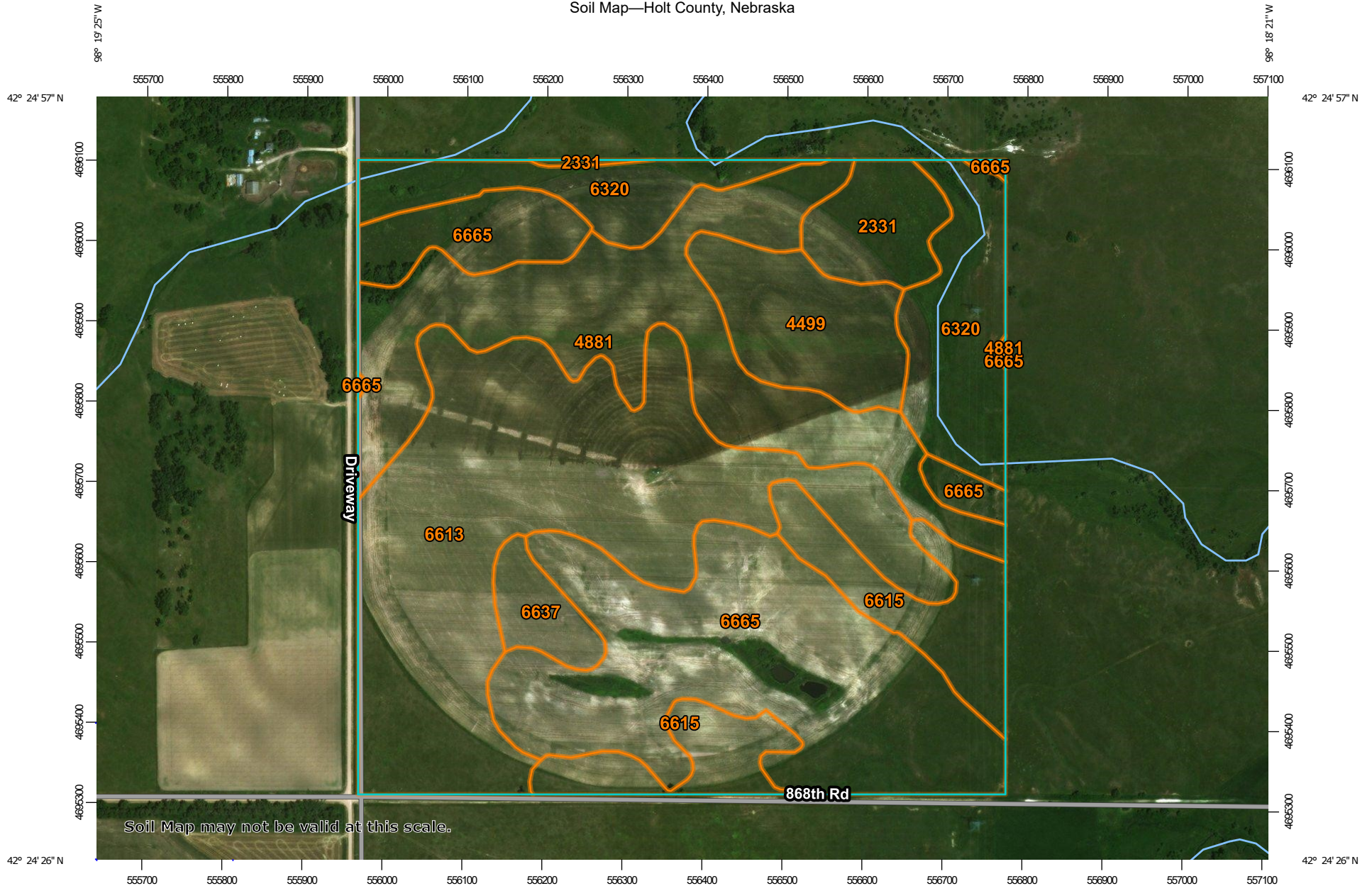
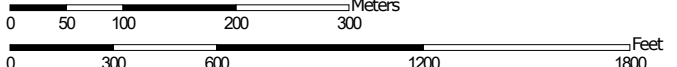


Soil Map—Holt County, Nebraska
