ORDINANCE NO. 0-2020-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CISCO, TEXAS AMENDING CERTAIN SUBSECTIONS OF CHAPTER 14 "OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS" OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES; SPECIFICALLY SECTION 14-73 "SEX OFFENDER PROHIBITION", ADDING ITEM (e) PROHIBITING EMPLOYMENT WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS BY A SEX OFFENDER REGISTERED IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION WITHOUT NOTIFYING CISCO POLICE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CISCO THAT:

Chapter 14, Article V, is amended to read as follows:

- 3. Section 14-73. "Sex offender prohibition".
 - (a) It is an offense for a sex offender to establish a permanent residence or temporary residence within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising a school, child care facility, child care institution, park or playground, or other places where children regularly congregate.

(b) It is an offense for a sex offender to knowingly enter a child safety zone.

- (c) It is an offense for a sex offender to knowingly loiter on a public way within 300 feet of a child safety zone.
- (d) A sex offender shall not, on each October 30th and 31st, or any other date set by the city for trick-or-treaters, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on the following morning leave an exterior porch light on or otherwise invite trick-or-treaters to solicit the premises.
- (e) A sex offender who is registered in another jurisdiction, and not currently registered with the local law enforcement authority, shall not maintain employment, either full time, part time, or temporary or seasonal, within the city limits of Cisco, Texas, without notifying the Chief of Police or his designee of such employment.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
