

15-year-old arrested in Tuesday shooting

Shreveport police have arrested a 15-year-old in connection with the Tuesday night shooting death of a man near downtown Shreveport.

Detectives Michael Price and Kevin Crow identified a suspect in the death of Terrence Harr, 34, of Bossier, who was found shot in the side about 9 p.m. in the 1000 block of Texas Street.

The detectives found the suspect at his home on Ponderosa Trail. The youth was questioned at police headquarters, then charged with second-degree murder and taken to the juvenile detention center, police said.

Under Louisiana state law, a 15-year-old can be charged as an adult in murder prosecutions, af-

ter a hearing before a juvenile court judge.
