The COV voted on the per-capita at its July meeting. The per-capita is as follows if paid in full by:

September- \$47.00 if paid by Sept. 30th November- \$56.00 if paid by Nov. 30th October- \$51.00 if paid by Oct. 31st December- \$61.00 if paid by Dec. 31st

Invoices will be mailed out September 1, 2018 to all GC's. Best price if paid early!

THINGS TO KNOW FROM THE JULY, 2018 COV MEETING

The selling of the Christmas raffle tickets allowed the COV to lessen the per-capita from \$50 per member to \$47 per member, if paid by September 30, 2018. This is a \$4 reduction than last year's per-capita. Please note procedures: The caravan bills the member "DUES". The member pays their caravan dues, whatever that rate is set by their caravan. The Secretariat then invoices the caravan per-capita based on the total membership as of September 1, 2018 to be paid on the scale above. It will be the responsibility of the caravan to pass on the \$4 savings to the member. This is the lowest reduction in per-capita we have had. This proves participating in the selling of the raffle tickets does help.
