

Approval of Minutes: Minutes from January meeting were published in the January newsletter. No changes needed. Moved by Joann Dalton, Seconded by Toni Totten and approved as written.

Shop Hop Bus in June. Michelle will make tickets and we will provide water. \$500 deposit due to Michael's Transportation. Michelle made the motion to sign the contract and pay deposit; Linda seconded. Motion carried.

b) Budget 2017 – Kris to compile 2016 budget worksheets for us to work on in February.

d) VP Facebook Page – to be used for information sharing only. Will not use the page for ads for members' businesses? Michelle made the motion, Kris seconded. Motion carries.

e) 2018 Op Quilt Promotion - Kris to give list of guilds visited in 2016 with the Opp Quilt.

f) Too soon to talk about 2020 Op Quilt? Mary to begin mentioning it at meetings.

g) Each board member receiving all forwarded emails to board from website?

h) Quilt Show - scaled down quilt experience. Linda to get prices from Peter for SC/GRVD

i) Broken Pro-panels at FDSC broken. Check with Peter to see if it can be fixed. Pricing for ourselves if we need to make a future purchase. Office Max - \$219 (\$164 with Linda's discount, measures 36x42)

k) Logo updated to use with promotional materials – old PowerPoint thumbnail is too small, fuzzy when enlarged. Kris to send jpeg/png versions to Joel. The only change is to the typeface – the block remains the same.
