ψ **United Synagogue California Fire Relief:** In the past week we have witnessed the devastation and loss of life that fire has caused across California. Our network of *kehillot* is an important source of support to our communities. We send our prayers to those in the path of the fires, the many who have lost their homes, and to those suffering from poor air quality across the state. Please pray for our communities, and the well-being of our fellow Jews. To help those in California, here are two steps you can take: support the Jewish Federation of Los Angeles which has created a [Wildfire Relief Fund](#), and please consider giving now to USCJ's Disaster Relief Fund. USCJ's funding often supports needs that other funders do not.

For example this past year, with your support, we helped:

- **Support the reconstruction of buildings after a fire at Camp Ramah in the Rockies;**
