Jack Davis, Jr., 71, of Caseville, died Wednesday afternoon, June 2, 2004, from a ruptured brain aneurysm, at St. Mary's Medical Center, Saginaw. He was born February 25, 1933 in Royal Oak Township to the late Curtis and Nellie (Cunningham) Davis. He was a U.S. Army veteran serving during the Korean War. Jack drove a truck for Allegany-Ludlum before coming to Caseville. He and his life partner, Ann Tosch, owned and operated the Sandcrest Market near Sleeper State Park for 14 years, selling and retiring in 1999.
