Women's Vollball

Nearly half of Princeton's Womens volleyball team are members of Tiger Inn. Including Kendall Peterkin, '16 (pictured right) who ranked second in the Ivy



League in points (3.87), third in kills (3.33) and recorded double-digit kills in 17 of her 23 matches, including season-best 21 in 3-2 win over Penn. She was named Ivy League Player of the Week after Princeton's victory over



Penn. Co-Captain, Sarah Hann (pictured left) recorded 84 kills in 59 sets (1.42 per).

Women's Water Polo

Katie Rigler '14 was named team co-captain this year. During fall 2013 she was invited to and participated in the USA Water Polo Futures 50 Classic.



She was awarded the Eastern Championship Tournament MVP both in 2012, and 2013. Also in 2013, Katie was an ACWPC All-America Honorable Mention, the Southern Division Player of the Year, first team selection, Eastern Championship and MVP and first team honoree. She played in 33 games, starting 32 while leading offense for the third straight year with 66 goals.

Men's Water Polo



Tiger Inn's undergraduate treasurer Drew Hoffenberg (pictured left) and rising senior Kevin Shannon (picture right) have been named Water Polo co-captains for the 2014 season. This is Drew's second tour as team co-captain sharing leadership with senior member Kurt Buchbinder '14 this past season. As a three-time All-America, Drew led the offense for the third consecutive season with 66 goals and 32 assists, while adding 40 steals and five blocks in 2013. He was also a Southern Division First Teamer and CWPA Championship All-Tournament

Team selection. Kevin scored 43 goals, made 15 steals, six blocks and recorded 38 ejections drawn in 26 appearances last year. He concluded the season earning his third ACWPC All-Academic Team Excellent honors.
