***HESS HANGS ON FOR CHAMPIONSHIP # 5***

**NOLAN'S SHOTMAKING RESULTS IN FIRST TOUR TITLE**

For the 6th consecutive event, the boys division has crowned a brand new champion. Alex Nolan held off all contenders to secure his very first GISBT championship. Nolan grabbed the lead midway through the match play finals, and fended off a position round challenge from collegiate teammate Justin Aboud. Nolan actually led Aboud by 121 pins with 2 games to go, but Aboud's 267 in game #7 set up a winner-take all position round match. There, Nolan survived a rough start, opening his first 2 frames, but a late 3-bagger was enough to close the deal. The battle was a classic match-up of Nolan's finesse and shotmaking versus Aboud's speed and power. In the end, Nolan made fewer mistakes and made more great shots than the others, and it resulted in his first GISBT championship.

(By the way, the record for most consecutive first time champions is 7 in a row; that streak stretched from September 2008 until March 2009.)

Nolan, a right-hander from Mokena, Illinois qualified in 2nd place at +50, trailing the leader by just 3 pins.

The champ averaged 210.37 for his 16 games. For his victory, Nolan was rewarded with a \$400 scholarship, and a permanent place on Champion's Row. Congratulations, Alex!

### **ABOUT RUNNER-UP IN BEST TOUR SHOWING**

Justin About was in the best form of his GISBT career, and it resulted in a runner-up finish. The lanky right-hander from San Jose, California qualified in 6th place, but posted the highest finals pinfall (1732) and the best match play record with 6½ wins and just 1½ losses to charge into the runner-up spot. This was the 4th match play finals of his promising career, and his highest-ever finish. His best previous effort was a 4th place showing at this year's season opener in Davenport.

### **GREIM CONTINUES ROLL, TAKES 3rd**

Zach Greim is now 3 for 3 in match play finals finishes in his tour career. The Poway, California native earned a \$225 scholarship by virtue of his 3rd place showing this time out; last month, he earned the runner-up spot, and he finished 7th in this season's opener in Davenport. The talented 2-hander needed a 210 in his final qualifying game just to advance to the finals. Once there, he steadily moved up the board throughout the afternoon.

After 3 events so far in 2021-2022, Greim now leads in the Bowler of the Year race.

### **DENTON MATCHES CAREER BEST FINISH WITH 4th PLACE PERFORMANCE**

Zack Denton was this month's 4th place finisher; he took home a \$200 scholarship. The Waverly, Iowa native was appearing in the 7th match play finals of his career, with 5 of those coming in the past 7 tour events. The hard-throwing righty also matched his best finish on tour; he previously finished 4th in a pair of tour stops in Muscatine and Waterloo.

### **ROTH FINISHES 5th**

Corey Roth, already a winner on tour this season, was back in the match play finals for the 3rd straight month, and the 6th time in his tour career. The 2-hander from Coralville, Iowa won a \$180 scholarship for his performance. Roth, current points leader Zach Greim and Jacob Bianchi are the only 3 players who have qualified for all 3 match play finals so far on the 2021-2022 schedule.

### **BIANCHI TAKES 6th**

Jacob Bianchi continues to establish himself as a major force on tour. The talented right-hander from Altoona, Iowa, rolled into his 3rd consecutive match play finals at this month's event. He topped the 43-player field in qualifying at +53, and eventually wound up in 6th place. The 16 year-old took home a \$160 scholarship for his day's work.

### **KOWALIK EARNS 7th**

Adam Kowalik was this month's 7th place finisher. The only left-hander in this month's boy's finals field, Kowalik earned a \$140 scholarship for his performance. The Homer Glen, Illinois resident was returning to the match play finals for the first time since his 3rd place showing at the Moline, Illinois tour stop back in February 2020.

### **KRAMER 8th IN TOUR RETURN**

Lucas Kramer returned to GISBT competition for the first time in more than a year, and he matched his best career finish at this month's event. The Marshalltown, Iowa native finished in 8th place, earning a \$125 scholarship. The 2-hander also finished 8th at the Moline, Illinois stop in February 2020. He was one of 3 2-handers in this month's boy's finals field.

## ***HESS HANGS ON FOR 5th CAREER TRIUMPH***

### **HESS BACK IN WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 5th TIME**

Megan Hess returned to the Winner's Circle for the 5th time in her career. The talented right-hander from Granger, Iowa grabbed the lead early in her qualifying round, and never looked back. Despite having the lead for more than 5 hours, her win didn't come easy. She survived a stern challenge from 2-time tour winner Brynna Madison, and she actually needed a 10th frame mark to come away with the title so her final victory margin of 60 pins was deceiving.

The champion entered the finals round with a 10-pin lead, and that lead eventually ballooned to 149 pins before being sliced to just 15 pins heading into the final position round. That match was a see-saw battle with both performers struggling with carry, despite some great shot-making along the way. Madison's late turkey forced Hess to mark in the 10th frame, and the 5-time champ delivered a clutch double on her way to the win.

### **HESS' LOVE AFFAIR WITH MAY CITY CONTINUES**

Hess was making the 13th match play finals appearance of her career; 5 of these have now resulted in victories. Her last win came a year ago – at the October 2020 tour event in Waterloo. 3 of Hess' 5 tour wins have come at May City Bowl. The 21 year-old also posted victories at the 32-lane center in March 2019 and March 2020.

Hess averaged 206.50 for her 14 games on a very challenging Turnpike lane pattern. She took home a \$350 scholarship for her victory. Congratulations, Megan!

### **MADISON CHARGES INTO RUNNER-UP SPOT**

2-time tour winner Brynna Madison staged a ferocious comeback in search of tour title #3, but in the end, she fell just short of a 3rd tour victory. With 3 games remaining, Madison trailed Hess by 149 pins, but she reeled off games of 246, 254 and 254 to move to within 15 pins of the eventual champion. Her 192-177 position round loss relegated her to the runner-up role. The Lincoln, Nebraska native was making her 4th match play finals appearance; she was rewarded with a \$275 scholarship.

### **EVANS NABS 3rd**

Gabi Evans rolled into her 8th match play finals at this month's tour stop. The smooth-stroking right-hander from West Liberty, Iowa eventually wound up in 3rd place, hauling in a \$225 scholarship for her efforts. The tour veteran owns a runner-up finish on tour, but is still searching for her first GISBT title.

### **MOORE FINISHES 4th**

Rachel Moore was this month's 4th place finisher. Last month, Moore broke into the GISBT Winner's Circle for her first tour victory, and this month she was back in good form again, qualifying for her 10th match play finals. The Keokuk, Iowa resident earned a \$175 scholarship.

### ANDREWS 5th IN FINALS DEBUT

Vicki Andrews enjoyed a career breakthrough at this month's event. The Indianola, Iowa resident made her match play finals debut, eventually finishing in 5th place after qualifying in the #2 position. At 14, she was easily the youngest of this month's match play finalists; she was rewarded with a \$150 scholarship for her finish. This was just the 5th tour appearance of her promising career.

### MCCARTHY TAKES 6th

Katrina McCarthy was back in the finals for the 3rd consecutive month. The southpaw from Pelican Lake, Wisconsin finished in 6th place this time around, capturing a \$125 scholarship in the process.
