Follow the same paths as the characters of Outlander on a journey from bellow to breeze and mountains to sea. We pick up Jamie and Claire's journey, just as they did, in historic **Charleston, South Carolina** where they



watched the pirate, Stephen Bonnet, escape hanging and hesitantly aided in his escape, which they later came to regret. Follow their tidewater trail north to the colonial port of **Wilmington, North Carolina**, teeming with

Scots in search of new lives and land in America. Here we will explore the **Cape Fear River** harbor, by boat, as did the Highland Scots on their way upriver to their frontier homes.

Next, we visit **New Bern**, the colonial capital and the palatial residence of **Governor Tryon**, who recognizes

the value of Jamie Fraser and negotiates land for loyalty. We then move up the Neuse River to Kinston, and over land to explore

Cross Creek and the **Cape Fear River** valley where the road to the backcountry and a new Fraser settlement begins.



Winding our way through the **Sandhills** we see the land of pines, tar and pitch that supplied the British Navy and allowed them to conquer the world. Here we will see the **Town Creek Indian Mounds** and pass by the plantation site of **Flora MacDonald**. We will end our Sandhills tour at a smaller version of Auntie Jocasta's **River Run**, set in the horse-shoe bend of a river and surrounded by fertile fields and pine forests.

Our path then meanders through the back-country capital of **Hillsborough**, where backwoods settlers rose against the Crown. Afterwards, we follow the same path as **Governor Tryon's troops to Alamance**, where the doomed Regulator insurrection ended, until the flame rekindled in 1776.




As we travel west we stop at **Old Salem**, the restored colonial village in Winston Salem, to trade with the Moravians and dine at The Tavern. Our journey continues west as we follow the Frasers' quest to find their place in a world of their own creation. We will search for Fraser's



Ridge in the **Blue Ridge Mountains** via the breathtakingly beautiful **Blue Ridge Parkway**.

Our last night will be spent in **Boone**, where we will attend the famed play and dine at one of the most beautiful outdoor theaters in the country. Centered around the frontiersman Daniel Boone and the fight for American Independence, **Horn in the West** is a thrilling look back at our nation's beginnings.
