Dr. Calvin Wheeler, MD is the Institutional Director of Undergraduate and Graduate Medical Education for The Permanente Medical Group, Inc. (TPMG) and he serves on the Regional Governance Committee for Community Benefit as well as the Regional and National Diversity and Inclusion Councils. He has served on the Board of Trustees of the California College of the Arts for 14 years, and he serves on the Committee on Trustees and the Academic Committee. He was inducted into the inaugural Contra Costa County Boule of the Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity in 2007. In his new role he has begun creating and serving on programs to improve our nation's and our local communities' health and improve the diversity of the physician pipeline and workforce.
