

Park District offering free concerts this summer

The Fox Valley Park District will stage a series of six free concerts on select Thursday nights in June and July, beginning June 9 with Chicago country supergroup Hillbilly Rockstarz at Montgomery Park.

The concerts are a collaborative effort involving the Park District and the Village of Montgomery.

June 9: Hillbilly Rockstarz at Montgomery Park (River Street and Mill Street, Montgomery).
