Time! We all experience the same time each day—24 hours. We cannot add to it or take away from it. We all complain that there is not enough time in the day to accomplish all we want to do. But do we ever ask ourselves what we are doing with our time?

For most of us there is the eight hour work day, and then the five to six hours of sleep time. So that leaves us with 11 hours of free time. Let's assume two and a half hours of meal time, and if you prepare meals perhaps another hour added to that. This leaves seven and a half hours of free time. So what are you doing with that seven hours?

In this week's lesson we see two different uses of time. One is good and one is destructive. Jesus takes the time to rest in order to serve, while David uses the time he is to be leading his people in battle, to commit adultery that will have disastrous consequences.
