The brightly colored globes on this hitch locator help you guide your vehicle's hitch to your boat trailer. The reflective globes, which can be seen at night, are attached to masts that extend to 65'. The masts attach to the bumper and hitch with magnets. Rotating 180 degrees, the globes can be viewed with side- or rear-view mirrors. When the globes come together, the trailer and hitch are aligned.

Install this bronze valve in your boat's raw-water cooling system to easily flush the boat's diesel or gas engines. Opt for the strainer (\$20), and the Quick Flush Valve system will let you run an antifreeze/water mixture through your engine for winterizing your boat. It can also turn your engine into a backup pump should your bilge pump fail.

Where do you stow all your seasonal gear once summer ends? Racor's answer: the HeavyLift. The elevated stowage platform stows dinghies, electronics, grills, and tube toys above your vehicle or boat. Rated to lift 300 pounds, the cable-and-pulley system is made of 14-gauge steel and should be easy to crank. You can buy a premade steel platform (\$50) from Racor that measures 4'-by-4'. Or, you can build one yourself up to 4'-by-8'.
