

**ST LAWRENCE O'TOOLE CEMETERY
IRISHTOWN, NB**

The St Lawrence O'Toole cemetery is a small country cemetery and is only available to registered parishioners of St. Lawrence O'Toole parish **or** to descendants of those families already buried within it.

The following prices are in effect for cemetery lots:

Single lot ¹	Registered parishioners	\$ 300.00
	Non-parishioners with family in the cemetery	\$ 600.00
Double lot ²	Registered parishioners	\$ 600.00
	Non-parishioners with family in the cemetery	\$ 1200.00
Columbarium niche ³	Registered parishioners	\$ 1200.00
	Non-parishioners with family in the cemetery	\$ 1600.00

¹ A single lot may be used for full casket burials or urn burials. The maximum number of urns that can be placed in a single lot are 4.

² A double lot may be used for full casket burials or urn burials. The maximum number of urns that can be placed in a double lot are 8.

³ A columbarium niche can accommodate up to 2 urns, but if the urns are relatively small, it could be used for 3 urns.

When a lot is purchased, it is recommended that a stone/monument be purchased as soon as is feasible. **Stones for single lots should not exceed 3 feet or 0.9 metres in width.** If a larger stone is preferred, a double lot will have to be purchased.

When a stone is purchased, please remember to call the cemetery caretaker so that he/she can be available for the placement of the 'flag' or 'marker'. This is important so that the monument company places the stone on the correct lot and/or in the proper location on that said lot. Do not attempt to place the 'flag' or 'marker' on your own.

It is recommended that one have a committal service for a burial. However, if a family wishes to bury a loved one without a committal, please contact the cemetery caretaker before having a private family burial. Not only will the caretaker let the family know how deep the urn should be placed. It is also important that the caretaker is aware of **where** the urn has been placed in the lot so that it will not be disturbed with future burials within that lot. It is also necessary to include the date and location of the burial for the cemetery records.
