





- Meritorious Flour. The sign measures20 1/4 X 24 1/4 inches.
- The sign above is very desirable due to the beauty of the many scenes depicted in the design.
- One of these signs sold in a Showtime Auction for \$18,150.



- Trademark Head
- It measures 13 ½" X 9 ½" and reads "Sleepy Eye Flour and Cereals Free. If not the Best Ask the Man." The statement on the sign depicts it was used to offer free samples of flour given in the stores that sold the flour for the Sleepy Eye Milling Co. It also has a fold out on the back so it could set on one of the stores counter tops.
- Some call this sign, the die cut sign since the metal is die cut around the trademark head.
- Again, a sign in this condition with the horsehair tassel still attached is rare indeed.



- That Sleepy Eye Flour. Measures 19"x13 1/4"
- There are more of these that come on the market then any of the other three but most of them have some sort of oxidation.



- This tin embossed sign in period wood frame.
- It measures 19 ½" X 27 ½".
- This sign sold in a Showtime Auction for \$44,000 plus a 20% buyer's premium that brought the total cost to \$52,800. The high cost of these metal signs can be attributed to advertising collectors of metal signs loving these Sleepy Eye pieces also.



- Museum Sign
- Sign was restored by the Sleepy Eye Historical Society and is located in the Sleepy Eye Depot.



- Top of Mill Sign
- This is one of the two signs that were on top of the Sleepy Eye mill.

- The other is decorated with a rose and called a demitasse spoon. This was put in packages of Koffio.












#### **2 COOKBOOKS**





- Old Sleepy Eye usually is facing the viewer's right and the border shows items such as canoes, bows and arrows, moccasins, and cooking utensils.




