

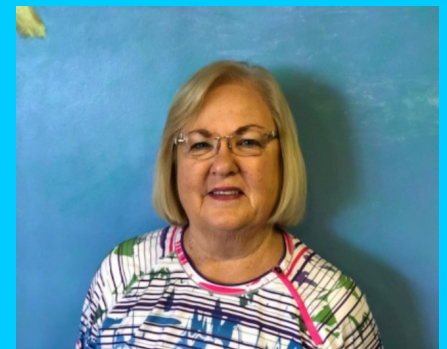

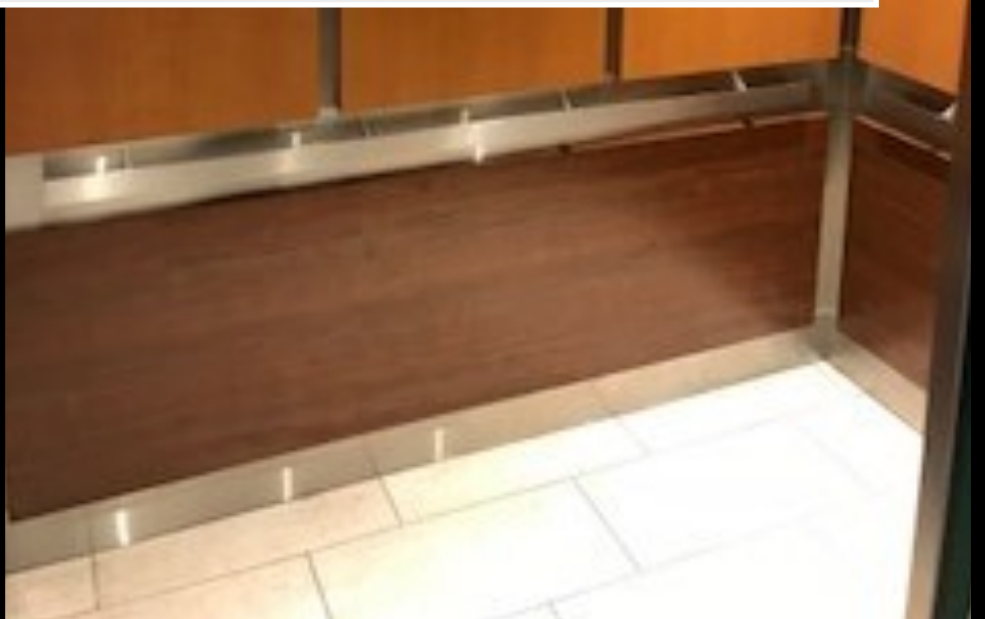


The new North large elevator cab is near completion,

while the two vendors complete everything to our satisfaction.

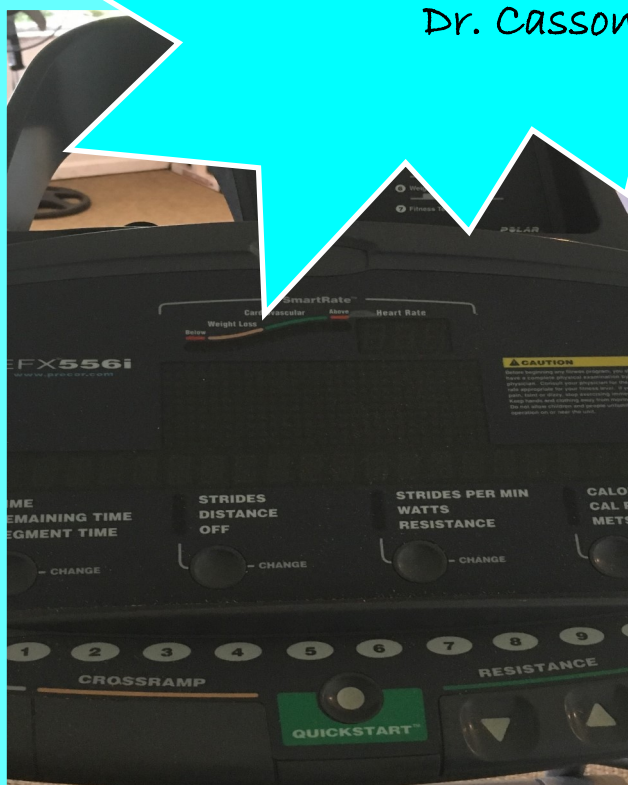
The safety feature of your new elevator doors edge does not allow for hold-

Does Your Garbage Disposal Stink?

Actually, the cure for this is much easier than you might imagine.

Method 1

Grab a citrus fruit, peel it and dispose of any seeds. Put the slices of fruit into the disposal and then turn it on.
