ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Applicant must be a member of the Texas Junior Brangus Breeders Association
- 2. Applicant must be an active TJBBA member in both the show ring and junior activities for at least two (2) years and participated in at least three (3) TBBA sponsored shows in one year.
- 3. Applicant must be single and a graduating high school senior.
- 4. Application must be received by May 10 with official high school transcript, SAT and (or) ACT scores.
- 5. The recipient of this scholarship may pursue any course of higher education.
- 6. To retain the scholarship, the recipient must complete at least one semester at a college, university or institute. If the course or semester is not completed, scholarship monies must be refunded to the scholarship chairperson. The scholarship funds will be paid to the school of the recipient's choice, as required, when the recipient submits evidence of enrollment.
- 7. Proof of enrollment or information regarding enrollment must be presented to the TJBBA scholarship chairperson by <u>October 1</u> of the year in which the recipient is named or the scholarship is forfeited. The funds forfeited will be reallocated to the scholarship account for future scholarships.
- 8. In the event that the recipient of this scholarship cannot enroll in a school for additional education by the above deadline date, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- 9. Application and three (3) copies should be mailed directly to the current Texas Junior Brangus Scholarship Chairperson. All applications will be judged by an appointed committee.
- 10. Applications must be **TYPED** and pages may be added as needed.
- 11. Application must include your current high school transcript, SAT and/or ACT score(s), three (3) personal references, which included the following: school principal/official, county agent/vo-ag or 4-H leader, and a Brangus breeder.
