Fishing licenses may also be purchased in Casper. We will make sure to get you to the fly shop or other vendor when you arrive.

Transportation: WCBO will be providing transportation from the Ramkota Hotel departing at 7:00am to Crazy Rainbow Lodge and returning to the hotel at approximately 5:00pm. Each drift boat will accommodate two people and your guide. Everything you need to enjoy a day on the river is included except adult beverages. If you would like a glass of wine, cold beer, or other adult beverage there is plenty of room in the coolers that are provided. The sun can burn you quick so dress accordingly! A good hat is highly recommended. If you forget the sunscreen no problem! The guides are well prepared to meet or exceed your needs. If you want to do some wading please bring your own or you can wet wade this time of year. Forgot something? No problem. There is a full fly shop at the lodge if you would like to purchase a hat, bandana, or just pick up a logo shirt!

Gray Reef of the North Platte River

If you're picturing the classic western fly fishing experience; open skies from horizon to horizon, big, wild trout, and plenty of solitude, fly fishing on the Grey Reef tailwaters won't disappoint.

Tail waters are known as great trout habitat, and the entire North Platte from Grey Reef to 70 miles downstream is first and foremost a trout fishery. The Reef has been managed with flushing flows, and fishing restrictions to produce a thriving trout population and some of the best trout fishing in the lower US.



With Crazy Rainbow's private land holdings, and lodging adjacent to the Gray Reef you will enjoy exceptional access to the river, freedom to wade fish whenever you like, and most likely be the first fisherman out on the water.

Rainbows make up over 90% of the fish at the Reef. With over 9,000 fish per mile in 2013, the potential for hooking a ten pound fish is high. Grey Reef is known for its easy going nature and the versatility to support all levels of expertise. It's a very easy river for a beginner, but can be challenging for an angler looking to dry fly fish, nymph fish, or streamer fish for large trout.

- Leaving the Ramkota Hotel in Casper, Wyoming at 9:00 a.m.

- 2nd stop - Buffalo, Wyoming (45 Miles). Small break for gas and snacks at the Kum & Go.
- 3rd stop - Meadowlark Lodge located in the Big Horn Mountains (43 Miles). 60 to 90 minutes for lunch.

After we have lunch at Meadowlark Lodge, we will head back to Casper the same way we came. Round trip will be around 315 miles. Should be back to Casper around 4:30 or 5:00 p.m. To have a little fun, we will play poker or dice and give a card out or roll the dice at every stop. There is no cost to enter the ride, however, you will have to pay for your own food and gas for the trip and maybe a small fee if you choose to enter the dice or poker game.
