



A Sweet Gift From Berta

Dear friends,

After many years of bringing Almond Tea Cake to church gatherings, I thought I would take this opportunity to share the recipe with you. Two things you need to know:

This is not Jan Sparkman's recipe, which was much more elaborate. For one thing I remember her telling me she ground up the almonds and added them to the flour mixture. And I think she baked it in an oversized fluted pan lined with parchment. It took hours to make.

This is not "my" recipe either. Ginny McGetrick made this cake and brought it once or twice, years ago, and everyone raved about it. When I asked her for the recipe she was very reluctant to share it because it is so very easy to make and she wanted to keep that secret. But she finally relented.

So here it is, with love from Berta:

Ginny McGetrick's Almond Tea Cake

Melt 1 ½ sticks margarine in large bowl in microwave.

Stir in one at a time:

- 1 ½ cup sugar
- 2 beaten eggs
- 1 tsp almond extract

In another bowl combine dry ingredients:

- 1 ½ cup flour
- 1/4 tsp salt
- ½ tsp baking powder

Add dry ingredients to wet ingredients and stir until blended.

(now you can wipe out the dry ingredients bowl with a dish towel and put it away – no dishwashing)

Line bottom and sides of 9" round pie plate or cake pan with foil, letting the extra foil extend beyond edges of pan. Pour batter into pan.

Sprinkle with about 1 oz. sliced almonds.

Bake at 350 for 30-35 mins.

When cool, lift out of pan by the foil, then peel foil off.

(now you can also put the baking pan away – no washing)

Let it fully cool, or even sit overnite uncovered, to let it dry out a little so it's easier to cut.
