Ordinance O-2014-42

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF KEVIN J. BARKLEY, JR. AS A FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR AMELIA VILLAGE FOR A PROBATIONARY PERIOD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Amelia Village, after conferring with the Police Chief, has recommended the appointment of Kevin J. Barkley, Jr. as a probationary full-time police officer for Amelia Village, and

WHEREAS, the Council of Amelia Village concurs in the appointment of Kevin J. Barkley, Jr. as a probationary full-time Amelia Village police officer, and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Kevin J. Barkley, Jr. is hereby employed as a probationary full-time police officer of Amelia Village at a starting salary of \$17.54 per hour.

SECTION II. This appointment is contingent upon Mr. Barkley passing pre-employment medical and/or psychological examinations and drug screening to ensure that Mr. Barkley is physically and mentally able to perform the duties of a full-time police officer and as required by the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.

SECTION III. In the event that Mr. Barkley does not successfully complete the required medical examination, he may continue to work as a part-time police officer at his current rate of pay.

SECTION IV. Pursuant Ohio Revised Code Section 737.17, Mr. Barkley shall serve a probationary period of six months, at such time the Mayor with the concurrence of Village Council shall remove him from the position or appoint him as a permanent full-time police officer.

SECTION V. All prior resolutions or ordinances or any part thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said resolutions or ordinances not inconsistent with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION VI. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VII. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the Police Department of Amelia Village has several vacant police officer positions and this appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary police protection to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this

ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MRS. GERBER moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

MS. ELLIOTT seconded the motion.
