TUITION + COSTUME PAYMENTS

- ★ Tuition: Due on or before the 15th of each month
- * Costumes: Total yearly costume payment due on or before November 16th, 2019
- * Late Fees: \$15 every three (3) days after the 15th of each month for any payments not submitted in full; additional days after the first three (3) days will be \$5 per day

CLASS PLACEMENT

- * September through early October is a trial-period for all of our students; please be patient as we assess students & place them appropriately within levels and classes.

- ★ Student class level changes are at the discretion of the instructor + Miss K

A Friendly Reminder of TDS Studio Rules and Regulations

- ★ Please remove all street shoes before entering the dance floor we do our best to keep our dance floors and the studio itself as clean as possible. We appreciate your cooperation!
- ★ Only students who are registered for classes are allowed to take classes. No children are to be left unattended in the waiting area or studio space at any time.
- * Please be prompt in dropping off your dancer and picking them up. No students are allowed to wait outside for their ride please wait in the waiting room of Studio I. We will not allow our students to hang around the studio if they are not dancing. Our faculty members are focused on running their classes and cannot be responsible to watch after students who are not participating in a class. We kindly ask the parents of our younger students to please come inside to pick up their child at the end of their class.
- ★ Missed classes may be made up within the same 30-day period. The make up class should be the same or similar style of dance and close to the same level. Please see your dancer's instructor for guidance.
- * <u>Dress Code:</u> All dancers should have the appropriate attire for their dance class(es). We take dress code & dancer presentation very seriously. If you are unsure of your dress code requirements, we have copies of our rules available in the office & on our website. Our faculty has the right to not allow a dancer to participate in class due to continued dress code violations.
- * If your dancer is not going to be able to attend class, please call the studio or email us and we will notify their instructor. Dancers with eight (8) unexcused absences and will not be allowed to participate in our Recital (in June 2020). It is very difficult our faculty to plan class and choreography around missing dancers, and it is also difficult for those students who ARE attending class to learn their routine properly.
- * Observation Weeks: TDS sets aside specific weeks for parents to observe their child's progress in their dance classes. For the focus of the dancers, and their safety, we do not allow guests to observe any classes at any time outside of the assigned observation weeks.
- * Snow Days & Weather Cancellations: TDS does not follow the Webster and Dudley school systems when it comes to cancelling classes. If there is no school, it does not mean that dance is automatically also cancelled! Weather can change from morning until afternoon, so please be sure to check the studio's information outlets and your emails on days when weather is questionable. We always notify of any class cancellations at least one hour prior to first class of the day.
