Mrs. Mary Henne, 38, wife of Victor Henne, was killed instantly last Thursday, (May 25, 1939) at the Henne farm. She died when a piece of a stump hit her in the head following a dynamite blast. She was the daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Stephen Boesch and was born April 4, 1901 in Winsor Township near Pigeon. On May 25, 1921, she married Victor Henne.

Surviving are her husband; four daughters, Ila, Lucille, Etta, and Shirley; her mother Mrs. Emma Boesch of Pontiac; five sisters, Mrs. Anna Grassel and Mrs. Mabel Boudre both of Detroit, Mrs. Ada Wideman and Mrs. Buelah Edler both of Pontiac, and Mrs. Selma Kaufman of Sebewaing; one brother, Edgar Boesch of Sebewaing.

Funeral services were held Sunday, May 28, 1939, with burial in New Bay Port Cemetery.
