Essay Tips

Be sure to:

- Have a title for your essay.
- Use a style and vocabulary that is comfortable for you, but you still need to make sure you are within the bounds of acceptable usage.
- After you have written a first draft, spend time "polishing" your essay.
 - o Make verbs strong and active, and make descriptions precise and powerful.
 - Your sentences should be constructed properly and pay attention to the flow of your ideas.
 - o Paragraphs need beginnings and endings.
 - o Remember to introduce and sum up.
- Indent the first line of every paragraph.
- Check your spelling. Use a dictionary, spell check or a friend.
- Check your punctuation.
- Check your grammar. Do all sentences have a noun and a verb? Is the tense correct?
- Check your capitalization. All proper nouns should be capitalized.
- Proof read your essay to make sure you have answered the question and it makes sense.
- Let someone else read the essay. Ask your English teacher or guidance counselor.
