MENOMINEE TOWNSHIP ELECTED OFFICIAL'S SALARY
OFFICE OF TREASURER

The following is a resolution to set the salary for the statutory duties of the elected official holding the office of Menominee Township Treasurer.

WHEREAS, MCL 41.95 authorizes Menominee Township Board of Trustees to determine the salaries for the offices of supervisor, clerk, treasurer, and trustees for fiscal year 2020-21 by adopting a resolution at least 30 days prior to the township annual meeting of the electors, and

WHEREAS, the township board deems that an increase in salary of the office of treasurer is warranted for FY 20-21; now

BE IT RESOLVED, that as of 1 April 2020, the annual salary of the office of treasurer is:

Treasurer: \$18,180.00

WHEREBY: The salary includes the same amount paid for the statutory duties as any member of the Board of Trustees which is presently set at \$2400.00. The remaining salary portion of \$15,780.00 is for doing the administrative statutory functions of the office of treasurer. This salary does not include compensation for non- statutory duties which falls under MCL 41.96 nor does it include compensation to attend County, State, or Federal meetings/training sessions outside of the township (See Twp Compensation Policy MTR-05-2013). A retirement benefit, as an incentive for continuance of service, is outlined in a separate township resolution which is effective for the current term of office and is not subject to the Annual Meeting. It is also noted that when the state doubled the tax collection administration, adding a Summer Tax season, there wasn't an increase in salary granted to the office of treasurer to compensate for that extra work;

THEREFORE, the treasurer's compensation will not be reduced if the state returns to a single billing season.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that this resolution be available to the electors at the annual meeting to be held on 21 March 2020. Pursuant to MCL 41.95 (7), modifications that may be made by the electors cannot result in a reduction of salary during an official's term of office unless the responsibilities and requirements of that office have diminished, and the official agrees in writing to that reduction. Electors may include a modification clause should a new treasurer be elected for the next term. In event that the electors fail to act on this resolution, the officer shall be entitled to continue the salary, IAW state law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is properly adopted by the Menominee Township Board of Trustees, as required by law.
