

## (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

All entries in these classes must be properly identified on the entry form. Entries in Brace are considered a unit and each entrant must be listed.

The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must be entered in the class and appear in the ring with the get or produce. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch does not need to be the owner of the get or produce.

**STUD DOG ČLASS** - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award is based on the merits of the get.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award is based on the merits of the produce.

BRACE CLASS - For two dogs of the same breed/variety with identical ownership.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

**Novice Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show and who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boy and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boy and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boy and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**Master Class -** For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767.BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the

Breed or Obedience classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step or half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIBIGLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after

the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class, provided that this transfer is to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

#### SHOW SITE AVAILABILITY:

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 4:00 pm, Thursday, March 1, 2018. Every effort will be made to obtain earlier access to the set-up area. Check the Entry Confirmation/Judging Program for the most current information regarding access times. Dogs must be removed from the show site by 8:00 pm Sunday, March 4, 2018. **TICKETS:** 

#### TICKETS:

- 1. There is no admission charged to exhibitors for these shows.
- 2. Exhibitor's identification tickets will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank and should be received within a reasonable time prior to the show. Contact the Secretary if tickets are not received to make sure you are entered. Secretary can provide this information only to exhibitors who have utilized the exhibitor code provided on the entry form.
- Tickets returned by the post office marked "undeliverable" will be held at the Superintendent's table.

#### FACILITY RULES:

- It is a violation of state law to bring alcohol, illegal drugs & weapons onto the Arizona State Fairgrounds. Any person(s) violating the state law will be escorted off the premises by Fairgrounds security.
- 2. Šmoking is not permitted in any of the buildings in accordance with state statute.
- 3. There will be NO vehicles allowed at any time in any of the show buildings.
- 4. Food and beverage stands will be available on the show grounds.
- 5. No food sales by vendors or exhibitors allowed.
- 6. Water is available at this site.
- 7. No glass containers are allowed on the property.
- Violations of rules & regulations or inappropriate behavior towards Arizona State Fairgrounds employees, Show Committee & officials or fellow exhibitors may subject any participant in this event to disciplinary action by the Show Committee.

#### CRATING, SETUPS & EXERCISE AREAS:

1. Security will be provided. However, dogs, equipment or personal items left on the show grounds are the responsibility of each exhibitor. Neither the Superstition Kennel Club, Inc., or any of the participating specialty clubs nor the Arizona State Fairgrounds is responsible for lost or stolen dogs or equipment.

2. Unreserved inside crating space is provided on a first come, first served basis. Roping off unused crating space is strictly prohibited & will be removed by the Show Committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates & any other remedies it may deem necessary for consolidating space.

3. NO ELECTRICAL CORDS allowed in aisles.

4. Exercise pens allowed outdoors only. Pens must be set up on polyethylene sheeting if mats or carpet are not used. Sawdust or comparable absorbent material used to cover the sheeting must be disposed of along with the sheeting when vacating your setup space.

5. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up his (her) own setup area on a daily basis. Remember to bring a broom.

6. Grooming & crating space is available in all buildings & outdoors.

7. Temporary crating of any breed at ringside is allowed only while that breed is being shown. This rule will be strictly enforced. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.

Dog bathing facilities will be available on the show grounds. Only cold water will be available.
 Dogs may not be left unattended in exercise pens or on grooming tables.

10. Dogs may be left overnight in the buildings.

11. Electricity is not available to unreserved setup spaces.

12. Generators may be used only outside the buildings in designated parking areas.

13. All dogs must be on leash at all times while on the show grounds, exept when in an exercise pen or obedience ring. Due to safety concerns, the use of retractable/flexi-leads on the show grounds is not permitted during show hours. All dogs must be on a lead not to exceed six (6) feet in length and under control at all times.

Reserved day of show/overnight parking is available for exhibitors wishing to set up grooming tables and exercise pens adjacent to their vehicles. See Reserved Parking Rules & Reserved Parking Application in the Superstition KC premium list available at www.onofrio.com

THIS SHOW is governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry blank in this Premium List.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and Photocopies of entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTA-BLE.

- NO ENTRY CAN BE ACCEPTED that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Telegraph or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors after closing date.
- ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in an exercise pen. There is no provision for un-entered dogs at this show.
- THE DALMATIAN CLUB OF GREATER PHOENIX may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee or because dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- THE CLUB AND ITS SHOW SECRETARY will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the Show premises. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times. The Club and its show secretary will not be responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.
- NO GROOMING TABLES, pens or exhibitor set-ups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the rings in areas specified by the club. No practicing is allowed in the rings at any time.
- DOGS MAY ARRIVE at any time prior to scheduled time of judging of their class. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or the AKC that requires a Judge to wait for a dog. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
- CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money and other prizes must be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over, and the Show Secretary advised at once.
- RECORDING & EVENT FEES: A Recording Fee of 50¢, Event Services Fee of \$3.00 will be required for Licensed or Member Club Show. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2.)
- TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED: Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries but whose title is unconfirmed may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made with the Show Secretary at least onehalf hour prior to the start of regular conformation judging at the show.
