Trip Highlights for January



2017 Big Sky Ski Trip February 7th - 14th:

Our trip is now only a short time away. The picture I hope will remind all of you on what to pack for those days on the slopes. Temperatures right now are at 8 degrees, with snow expected everyday this week. The base is 48" on the upper mountain and 32" on the lower mountain.

Plans are now all set for our trip and a complete package will be coming out next week. I am just waiting for the final location of the welcome party and the après ski parties. The hotel does not set up the location until 30 days before.

We have 52 people taking the trip to Montana. Confirmations have been made for 23 people to go to Yellowstone. Several are going to venture out on snowmobiles while others will be taking a snow coach. The sleigh ride and dinner should be lots of fun with 21 people attending. The dinner is a family style prime rib dinner with cowboy singing. The menu looks great.

I am finalizing the menu for our Awards dinner at Bucks T4. Since we are a group of 40 for dinner we must choose from one of two menu items. I will be sending the choices out to all of you shortly. I will need to provide the restaurant with our choices before we make our trip.



2018 Snowmass Ski Trip February 6th-13th:

Our Snowmass contract is complete. We will be either staying at the Stonebridge Inn or their condos at the Terrace House. The Stonebridge Inn just went under a complete renovation with modern hotel rooms in the style of a rustic lodge. It has a heated outdoor pool and hot tub, fitness room, sauna, internet access an onsite laundry, and ski lockers on site. Rooms also have a refrigerator.

For those staying in the Stonebridge Inn a hot breakfast is included each morning. Those in the condos can add the breakfast for an additional charge.

Pricing which includes breakfast, transfers, 5 day lift tickets and room is as follows:

Stonebridge Inn - Seniors: \$1349.03 per person

All others: \$1471.25 per person

Terrace House - Seniors: \$1045.32 per person

All Others: \$1167.54 per person

2017 Cruises:



January 14th-21st on Holland America's ship the Eurodam round trip from Fort Lauderdale: This cruise goes to the Western Caribbean and includes stops at Half Moon Cay, Key West, Cozumel and the Cayman Islands. This year we have eight of us taking this trip. We were all fortunate and got a free beverage package with our registration.

March 7th-21st on Holland America's ship the Zaandam from Santiago Chile to Buenos Aires Argentina. We have six of us making this adventure. All of us are going to tour Santiago and do some wine tasting before boarding the ship. We will be seeing many penguins and fjords as we make our way around South America. Two days will be spent in Iguassu Falls after the ship lands in Buenos Aires. The falls are about 2 ½ miles long and border Brazil and Argentina. Our final stop will be spent in Buenos Aries in the Palermo district which is the in spot now in the city.

October 7th-20th: Montreal to Fort Lauderdale on Holland America's ship the Veendam. This looks to be a fun cruise starting in the wonderful city of Montreal during leaf peeping season. For those who like Lobster there is a great opportunity to imbibe on the crustacean in Bar Harbor. Prince Edward Island is known for their wonderful mussels.
