Definitions

Junior Rider = 17 or under

Senior Rider = 18 and older

Novice Rider = First year of showing at that level

Novice Horse = First year of showing Dressage

Entry requirements

Only one horse/rider combination per entry form; make copies as needed. All names will appear in the show program as they appear on the entry. Signatures are required for all owners, riders, and parents/guardians of junior riders.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded through 6th place in each class. Trophy for first place in junior classes. It is your responsibility to collect tests and awards. Anamchara Stables will not mail these items.

Refunds

After closing date, refunds (less a \$15 charge) will be given only upon receipt of vet certificate.

Arenas

Competition arena available for warm-up and lunging until one hour prior to show start.

Warm-up arena available all day. No lunging after closing of competition arena.

Children & Pets

Dogs are not allowed at facilities; children must be supervised by an adult.

Turnout

ASTM/SEI approved helmets and boots required for everyone. Show clothes are not required.

Schooling devices such as draw reins, martingales, etc. are not allowed in the competition or warm up arena.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

All ride times will be given by phone or email the week of the show.

Stallions Policy

Stallions will not be permitted on show grounds.

Trainers Schooling Horses Policy

If your trainer (or anyone else) schools your horse on the show grounds, he/she must sign the Release on the Entry Form before mounting the horse.
