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

Sunday Forum May 6th

Holly Hoey-Germann will present our Sunday Forum on May 6th after the 10:00am Mass. Holly will speak about the results of an unprecedented two-year national study on why young people are leaving the Catholic Church. The report, entitled *Going, Going, Gone: The Dynamics of Disaffiliation in Young Catholics,* explores the reasons young people are leaving the Catholic Church and religion in general. Holly is a religion teacher at Totino-Grace High School who was invited to participate in a national symposium in Baltimore to discuss the findings of the report. Holly will share results of the study as well as her own insights as a high school religion teacher for more than 20 years. Holly's presentation will provide helpful background information for us as we prepare for St. Cecilia's annual Parish Assembly on Sunday, June 3rd. This year's Parish Assembly will focus on this topic of disaffiliation of young Catholics. Join us on May 6th. All are welcome!

Racial Reconciliation

Fifty years ago, the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. gave his "Mountain Top" speech, and was assassinated the following day. While there have been improvements, many effects of systemic racism remain rooted, often in hidden ways. A group is beginning to meet, using a 12-step format, to examine the effects of systemic racism in ourselves and to move toward racial truth and reconciliation. The first meeting is Tuesday, April 17th, 7:00pm, with another meeting on Saturday, May 5th at 10:30am. Meetings are expected to last 90 minutes.
