

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Behold the Lamb of God.”
Matthew 1:35-42

Today’s Psalm, “Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will” is the response of John the Baptist to God’s call to “prepare the way of the Lord.” People were drawn to John, not because he proclaimed his own greatness, but because he understood that there was one to come after him who was greater than he. When he saw Jesus walk by he proclaimed, “Behold the Lamb of God.” John accepted and fulfilled his role to prepare the way for the “man who ranks ahead of me” and not to seek his own glory. He directed his followers to Jesus. They became his disciples and eventually responded to God, “Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will.” Do we accept the role God has given to us and stand ready to say, “Here I am, Lord; I have come to do your will” when God calls us to be all that he has created us to be and prepare the way for Jesus to enter our lives and the lives of others.
