in the above entitled case, to-wit:-

That he has been, & still is the
family Physician of Mrs. Ellen Rose,
for the past three years, and that she
is a woman ^{of excellent} Moral character, and
a Christian.

That on the 27th day of February
1916, the said Archibald Rose, de-
serted his Wife, Mrs. Ellen Rose, the
applicant in this case, and went
to California and became an in-
mate of the National Soldiers and
Sailors Home at San-tell Calif-

That at the time of his leaving
this State, the said Archibald Rose
was receiving a Pension from the
U.S. Govt of \$30.00 per month



that since that time he has not contributed anything towards the support of his wife. The said Ellen Rose and that at the present time she is in necessitous circumstances and that by reason of her age and infirmities she is totally unable to support herself by Physical labor.

That she is not now nor ever has been an inmate of any institution or home provided for the wives of soldiers or sailors or their children.
