
The Expanded Calico Rock Museum & Visitor Center

The door on the right side leads into the foundation and magazine offices. The entry on the right leads into the art center and public restrooms. The tin ceiling in this room will be 10 feet tall and the columns will be wrapped.



This is a view of the new galleries in the Tomlinson Art & Science Center. The expansion doubles the number and capacity of the galleries in the art center. Over the next few weeks, we will put the art and science center back together and ready it for reopening in March.
