# AMANA NEWS AND NOTES

#### Major Milestone for Amana Church Restore Revive Renew Project

Woodruff Construction, an Iowa company with offices in Fort Dodge, Ames and Tiffin, has been hired to restore the Amana Church meetinghouse, while Sandersfeld Construction, Amana, will restore the Middle Amana Kinderschule.

As a release from the Amana Church stated, "After an exhaustive search these two companies were selected based upon their experience, expertise and their desire to be part of this nationally recognized project. Work involves a major restoration of the exterior of the Amana Church meetinghouse and the conversion of the Middle Amana Kinderschule for use as the Amana Colonies Food Pantry."

The project is part of the National Trust for Historic Preservation - National Fund for Sacred Places program and was one of 15 places of worship across the country chosen in 2022 for grant funding. A \$70,000 construction grant has been awarded while a \$3,500 training and preparation grant was received from the National Fund Sacred Places program.

Amana Church members, the Amana Society, Whirlpool and friends of the church, Amana merchants and the NE Iowa Community Foundation have contributed to the Restore Revive Renew fund drive to complete the work. Thus far \$404,300 has been raised in donations and pledges totaling 72 percent of the total needed to complete the project. That total is \$563,862, reported Julie Zuber, Amana Church treasurer. Alex Momany, Amana Church Society president, said, "This project has been an amazing opportunity for us to come together as a community and rekindle our appreciation for our heritage. It has been a wonderful experience working with people who are passionate about this project both within our own community and at the organizational level. The significant scale of this project is matched only by its importance and the overwhelming support we have received. We are very excited for what the future holds."

Work at the Amana Church meeting house includes:

- New handicapped accessibility ramp
- Rebuild fire egress stairs
- · Remove existing non historic siding
- Replace/ restore wood siding
- Restore windows
- · Reconstruct entry stairs and entryways, in

- Fascia /soffit repairs
- Foundation repairs
- Relandscaping on east end to allow for sidewalk.

Work at the Middle Amana Kinderschule for conversion into the Amana Colonies Food Pantry includes:

- Install walkway/ driveway
- Restore/ replace siding
- Repair deteriorated framing
- Restore/ or replace windows and storm win-
- Repair entry porch
- Install utilities and make electrical updates
- Repair foundation and chimney

Construction will begin in September and is expected to take about 4 – 6 months, noted Elly Hoehnle, Amana Church administrator.

ACLUD permits have been received and final plans and estimates are being reviewed by the National Fund for Sacred Places Program staff, she added.
