

# **DANCE UNLIMITED**

## **Social Distancing Policies**

### **Effective until Further Notice**

According to the Minnesota Department of Health current COVID-19 social distancing policies, these rules and policies must be followed by all families, dancers and staff participating in dance classes at Dance Unlimited:

#### **ENTERING AND EXITING**

- \* All persons age 6 and above must wear a mask to enter our facilities.
- Please enter the lobby area one person/family at a time. Parents may drop off their child, and then we ask that parents leave the building.
- \* Parents of Preschool & K-1 students may stay in the lobby, but are not required to do so. Please limit to one parent, keep your distance from others and wear a mask at all times.
- Dancers will exit from the studio one at a time. When possible, parents are asked to wait outside (SLP and Long Lake), or in the common hallway area (Wayzata) for students to be released from class. Please be sure to be on time to pick up your child.
- Please limit adult drop off to one person whenever possible.
- Social distancing should be observed in all areas.
- Please limit food consumption inside the studio.

#### **CLEANING & HYGIENE**

- We have increased the frequency of cleaning practices in our lobby and studio spaces. Dance floors and door handles will be cleaned between each new group of students.
- Staff will wash and/or sanitize hands before and after each class.
- Staff will wear masks while teaching.
- \* Parents must wear a mask at all times.
- Dancers (ages 6+) must wear a mask into the dance studio and to their marked spot. Masks will be optional while dancing and doing physical exercise.
- Hand sanitizing stations are in the lobby and in each dance studio at all three locations. Please wash or sanitize hands before arriving to the studio as well.
- Posters with handwashing reminders are posted in restrooms.

#### **WELLNESS**

- Staff members will receive regular updates on information and safety training as it relates to preventing community spread of COVID-19.
- Any staff member or student showing signs of sickness will be sent home.
- Please do not attend classes if you have fever or respiratory symptoms or live in a household with someone exhibiting fever or respiratory symptoms. Parents should plan to take their child's temperature at home before coming to class.
- Please do not attend classes if you have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- Please do not attend classes for 14 days following a visit to an area where there is "widespread sustained community spread" of COVID-19

#### **DANCE STUDIOS**

- Class sizes are limited to allow for social distancing.
- Our dance floors have social distancing marks in each studio.

- Staff will wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer between every class.
- Please bring a water bottle, clearly labeled with your dancer's name. Drinking fountains are not to be used at this time.
- Dancers will bring their dance bags into the studio for changing shoes.
- Dancers should arrive dressed in dance attire. Restrooms will not be available for changing clothes.
- Barres will be sanitized between each class that utilizes the barre.
- We will not be distributing stamps or stickers to our young dancers at this time.
- Students will be released one at a time to maintain social distancing.

### **RESTROOMS**

- Students should plan to use the restroom at home before coming to class.
- Restrooms use will be limited and will be cleaned regularly.
- If a student needs to use the restroom during class, using a paper towel to open the door handle upon exiting is suggested.
