God addresses His living Word to His believers. It shouldn't stay unanswered. All of us have our own approaches and interpretations about it according to our God given graces. God's creature is powerful and strong with graces God gives him/her. Our life itself is an area of the spiritual activities first of all because divine graces are for spiritual service. There are lots of things to do in this life but as the apostle Paul says: "Everything is permissible," but not everything is beneficial. "Everything is permissible," but not everything is edifying." (1 Corinthians 6-12)

The faith will be the greatest answer towards God's call. The faith always keeps you with God. It's with you when you feel strong and successful and also it's with you when you feel weak and failed in your mission, bodily and spiritually. We are allowed to do everything and the choice is ours. But the thing is when you do something wrong you feel guilty and like you haven't done anything but when you do something good, big or small it brings you spiritual satisfaction which makes you feel the communication between you and God.

(<u>1 Peter 2:1–2</u>)
