# SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR ADULTS

<u>Winsum</u> class meets in the conference room and is led by Bob McLin or Rod Seal. Their studies vary in subject matter but center around the current day studying Christian life as it relates to the bible while using each individual's personal bible preference. Modern bibles are becoming more sophisticated and new translations help give aid and insight into the original scriptures. The church has selected the NIV translation as a basis or center ground and is the selection for our sanctuary pew bibles. Worship scripture readings coincide with the pew bible.

# **SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR KIDS:**

#### Noah's Ark Nursery for Infants through Pre-Kindergarten:

Held in the Nursery, with teacher Linda Linfoot. She uses Gospel Light curriculum for young children, provides crafts and play to help children up to kindergarten learn more about the Bible and all God has provided for us, applying it to their lives as they grow and develop. It is not unusual to see children 2 years - 6 years at the same table coloring and pasting to make pictures about the Bible story to take home. Children, ages birth - Kindergarten are welcome at Noah's Ark.

#### Kids Ages Second Grade through Fifth Grade:

Led by Sandy Reems, using material from Gospel Light. This group meets in the Sunday School wing each Sunday at 9:15

#### Middle School/High School:

Led by Nicole Langreder and meets at 9:15 on Sunday mornings. This group (Grades 6-12) has included scripture, videos, and discussions; and they go on outings following church on some Sundays. This group of kids also attends many of the Christian-based camps which are scheduled in various places in Colorado throughout the year.

# **VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL:**

Each summer we have Vacation Bible School for kids from all over the community, ages preschool thru sixth grade with various fun activities. It is a week-long event from 9:00-12:00 each day, and is scheduled anywhere from June to August.

# **KIDS' CHURCH:**

Each Sunday there is Junior Church, held in the Sunday School wing. The kids are led directly from the Minister's Children's Sermon held in the Sanctuary, by the leader for that particular Sunday. The leaders rotate each Sunday and currently include Maggie Miller, Renea Carter, Joann Rodriguez and Linda Gallagher. Each leader presents on their particular Sunday a Bible-based subject of study for the kids to participate in, after which, rejoin the adult worship service to participate and share in communion.
