Amen.] **Celebrant or one concelebrant. He strikes his breast with his right hand, saying:** To us, also, your servants, who, though sinners, **And, with hands extended, he continues:** hope in your abundant mercies, graciously grant some share and fellowship with your holy Apostles and Martyrs: with John the Baptist, Stephen, Matthias, Barnabas, (to be continued:)

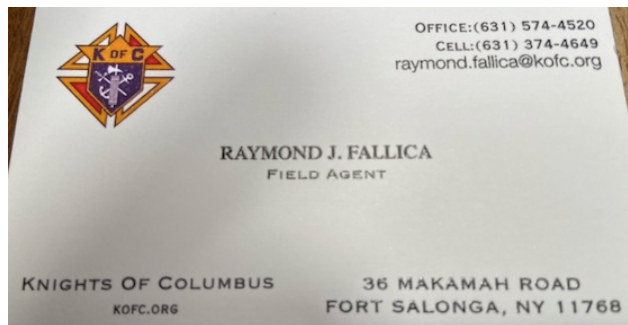
