#### Public Budget Hearing, November 8, 2021

#### (For Towns under 3,000 Levy Limit Increase)

Attendance: Richard Christel, Chairman, Adam Schetter, Supervisor, Lewy Schema, Supervisor, Pam Schneider, Treasurer, Craig Zipperer, Road Superintendent, Town Clerk Paulette Vogt, and Randy Knier.

Public Meeting on Proposed 2022 Budget: Chairman Richard Christel called the Public Hearing to Order at 8:06 p.m.

Treasurer Pam Schneider, a town member, stepped down from the Board as Treasurer, and became one of the public attendees and as there was a lack of public attendance at the hearing. Chairman Christel explained the debt adjustment to the residents attending, regarding 1-2021 "Resolution Approving the Use of Carry-Over Tax Levy Capacity", and regarding Resolution 2-2021 "Resolution of Town Board Proposing to Exceed Levy Limit". No questions were asked by the public

Supervisor Adam Schetter moved to adjourn Public Hearing at 8:12 p.m., seconded by Supervisor Lewy Schema, and unanimously approved.

### Town of Eaton

#### Special Town Electors Minutes – November 8, 2021

Chairman Richard Christel called the Special Town Electors meeting to order at 8:13 p.m.

Chairman Christel explained the need for Resolution 1-2021 – "Approving the use of Carry-Over Tax Levy Capacity" Chairman Christel looked for a motion, Pam Schneider moved, seconded by Randy Knier to adopt resolution 1-2021. Unanimously approved by the Electors.

Chairman Richard Christel explained the need for Resolution for Electors to Exceed the Levy Limits (Resolution 3-2021 at the Special Town Meeting of Electors which would be a dollar increase of \$75,049.00 The amount (\$29,996.20 for the one year payment of the salt shed) and (\$23,702.98 for the one year payment of the plow truck) totaling \$53,699.18. Due to the raise in the cost of the Valders Ambulance contract and also due to the insufficient money for set aside costs, the Board felt it was advantageous for the levy to be increased to also include the one year ambulance cost of \$21,350. This would alleviate decreasing the amount of money for the town road construction budget.

Chairman Christel looked for a motion, Pam Schneider moved, seconded by Randy Knier to adopt Resolution 3-2021. Unanimously approved by the Electors.

Chairman Christel looked for a motion, Pam Schneider moved, seconded by Randy Knier to adopt the 2021 Town Tax Levy. Unanimously approved by the Electors.

Supervisor Schetter moved to adjourn the Special Town Electors Meeting at 8:14 p.m., seconded by Supervisor Schema, and unanimously approved.

**SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING TO ADOPT  
2021 Tax Levy**

Chairman Richard Christel called the special town board meeting to order at 8:15 p.m. Supervisor Schetter moved to adopt the 2022 Budget and 2021 Tax Levy, Chairman Christel 2<sup>nd</sup> the same. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Lewy Schema made a motion to adjourn the special meeting. Supervisor Schetter 2<sup>nd</sup> the same. Motion carried unanimously.
