Medication Alert – Do Not Use These. Ever.

Highly Allergic: Sulfa drugs (specifically Sulfamethoxazole/Trimethoprim – brand name Bactrim)
Any medication or food with Red Dye 40

Total Fails - Evil Side Effects: Depakote
Neurontin

Ineffective (but not evil...): Trileptal

By Prescription:

Lamotrigine ER 24 Hr 200 Mg Tab -- 2x a day (1 morning, 1 at bedtime – 400 Mg total per day)

Lithium Carbonate 300 Mg Tab -- 3x a day (1 morning, 1 afternoon, 1 bedtime – 1050 Mg total per day with addition of capsule below)

Lithium Carbonate 150 Mg Cap – 1x a day (1 at bedtime – 1050 Mg total with addition of tablets above)

Clonidine Hcl 0.2 Mg Tab -- 2 at bedtime (0.4 Mg total per day)

Lorazepam 2 Mg --3x per day (1 morning, 1 afternoon, and 1 at bedtime – 6 Mg total per day)

*Lorazepam 0.5 Mg Cap PRN – 1 or 2 per day as needed for anxiety

Syeda- 1 per day (afternoon), do not use placebos

*Prescription allows for .5 mgs x 2 per day PRN for high stress periods, but due to the highly probability of increased tolerance, we use it very sparingly

OTC:

Claritin Liqui-Gels loratadine 10 mg antihistamine – 1 x a day (morning) (to control constant hive outbreaks)

ProBio Gold (probiotic supplement) 1 per day (morning)

Melatonin- 6mg 1 per day (bedtime)

Vitamin D 2000 iu (morning)

Hibicleanse (wash for underarms, under breasts and in skin folds)

Zeabsorb powder (1/2 Excess Moisture formula, 1/2 Athlete's Foot formula mixed and applied with a powder puff). Replaces deodorant, and also used under breasts and in skin folds
