BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1001 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. No business entity shall be required to provide any services, accommodations, advantages, facilities, goods or privileges related to any lesbian, gay, bisexual or transgender person, group or association.
- B. The refusal of a business entity to engage in any activity described in subsection A of this section shall not result in a civil or criminal fine under state or local law based upon the refusal.

- C. Any business entity refusing to engage in an activity described in subsection A of this section shall be immune from civil liability for any damages caused by said refusal.
- D. As used in this section, "business entity" means a person, partnership, general partnership, limited partnership, corporation, limited liability company or any other entity conducting lawful activity which is organized pursuant to the laws of the state or which is authorized to do business in the state if organized under the laws of another jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
