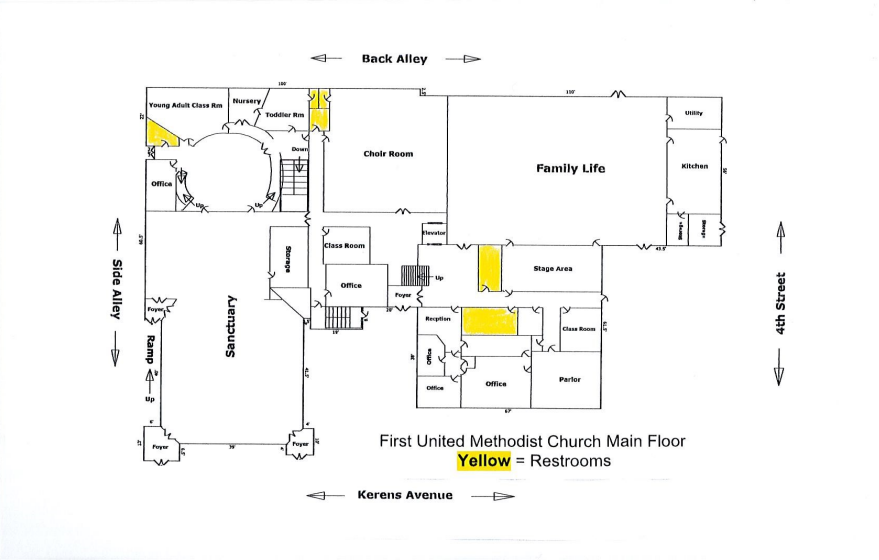
Programming Notes:
