Violet was proud of her English and Irish heritage; and traveled to England with her family a few times and to Ireland with her daughter and granddaughter at the age of 90. Violet was truly an amazing woman, who served as an inspiration to all who knew her. She is survived by her son Larry Gilbert, her daughter, Marlene DeLuca, grandchildren Jolene, Diane, John and wife Karen, Amy DeLuca, Robert Ike, and great grandson, Ian DeLuca, and many nieces and nephews.
