Western Heritage Riders Hit The Trail

Lake Charles – It's a tradition like no other. Each year, scores of cowboys and cowgirls head west toward Lake Charles via the week-long Western Heritage Trailride, sponsored by The Sanchez Burke Law Firm. A merry cavalcade of wagons and horses, the ride begins in Gueydan on Jan 29th and makes overnight stops in Lake Arthur, Jennings, Welsh, and Iowa before ending in Lake Charles just in time for the trail riders to participate in the annual Western Heritage Rodeo Parade. The parade will take place at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 3. The parade begins on Ryan Street at E.
