



FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC

The Palos Fire Protection District will establish an initial eligibility list for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic. Applications will be available June 13, 2016 through June 24, 2016, during the hours of 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM, M-F, at Palos Fire Protection District, 8815 W. 123rd Street, Palos Park, Illinois, 60464. **Applicants must appear in person, show a valid driver's license as proper identification, and pay a \$35.00 application fee (checks only – payable to the Palos Fire Protection District** to obtain an application. Applications are limited to one per person. Applications must be stamped with a time and date when filed with the District Office. Applications not date and time stamped before 4:00 pm on June 24, 2016 will not be considered.

Age Requirements: Applicants must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age at the time of hire and under thirty-five (35) years of age on the last date of submission of applications for original appointment unless otherwise provided by state or federal law and District Policy.

Scope of Examination: The examination shall consist of a written test and an oral interview. The examination shall be scored on a 100-point scale. Candidates may also be able to claim the following Preference Points: Educational Points (5 points maximum), Experience Points (5 points maximum), and Veterans Points (5 points maximum).

Examination Schedule: **A Mandatory Orientation session will be held at 7:00 PM, August 5, 2016 at Palos West Elementary School, 12700 S. 104th Ave, Palos Park, Illinois, 60464.**

Written examination shall be held at 9:00 AM August 6, 2016 at Palos West Elementary School, 12700 S. 104th Ave, Palos Park, Illinois, 60464.

Candidates receiving a passing score will have their oral interview scheduled immediately following the written test.

Physical Ability Requirements: Applicants must provide proof of a current and valid CPAT card with ladder climb certification (date within one year) with their completed application and again at time of conditional offer of employment.

Additional Requirements: Applicants must supply a copy of his/her Certified Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter certification and IDPH paramedic certification with the completed application.
