Reading comprehension or a reading based activity will take place four days a week. The 'teacher of the day' will also read a chapter book to children at the end of the day.

<u>English</u>

We will be using Talk for writing activities, which are designed to support children with speaking, listening, reading and writing. This will be sent in assignments, we will allocate different pages to work on each week. The 'teacher of the day' will introduce the lesson, children will then be give an allotted time to complete the work and then go through the work together at the end. Our first unit is 'The Magical Box'.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be following White Rose for Maths. On the days, Maths is time tabled, the 'teacher of the day' will introduce the lesson and include a video that goes through the learning. A worksheet will be uploaded to support the lesson. Children will be given an allotted time to be able to complete the worksheet during the live lesson. These sheets will initially consolidate previous learning and move onto new learning later this half term. This half term we will be covering;

Place Value, Multiplication, Addition and subtraction

<u>Feedback</u>

Feedback to work for Maths and Reading Comprehension will happen at the end of the live lessons. The teacher of the day will share answers at the end of the lesson and the children will self-mark. Teachers will give feedback for one piece of writing a week.

<u>Topic</u>

Topic will be stripped back so the activities are easily accessible and can be carried out independently. Our current topic is 'Street Detectives', so we will be taking a closer look at the area we live in. Topic activities will take place on a Wednesday with a short intro from our 'teacher of the day'.

<u>P.E</u>

P.E for Year 2 will be on a Friday so please make sure children come to school on Friday in their P.E kit.
