Dr Jan Boyd then followed on presenting Rules and information and her knowledge on gear checking, with great discussion on what is required, permitted and not permitted with saddlery.

Jayke Kerr then imparted knowledge on the presentation of your horse in the Dressage arena.

Everything was covered from plaiting, sharks' teeth and quarter marks, to what saddle blanket may suit your horse to help with the overall picture of making your horse aesthetically pleasing.

Jan then explained the Judges' Scale of Marks, pencilling shortcuts and explained how to pencil. Anne gave some tips on how to maximize your marks in a Preliminary test.

A demonstration test ride of the Preliminary 1.2 was then given by our SADA Club Member Mel Adamson, with the whole group pencilling for the test. A great morning was had by all!

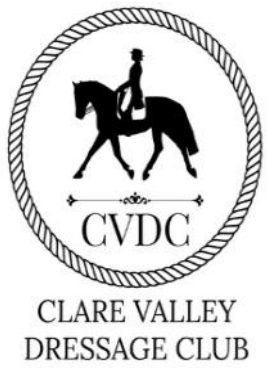

HOTY, POTY and YOTY are "AHDC Members only" Awards

Riders must be full financial members of AHDC at the competition when they ride their test/s (Day Members are NOT included) to have their points counted.

Points in a class are awarded to AHDC members only, regardless of how many riders in a class. They are then ranked into the top six placings. So if a member places 2nd in a class (behind a non-member), they will be awarded 6 points as the AHDC member winner of that class and so on.

1st place - 6 points, 2nd place - 5 points, 3rd place - 4 points, 4th place - 3 points, 5th place - 2 points, 6th place - 1 point. Points are recorded during the year and include scores over 55% from all of our competitions except (February CT, April Protocol day and October Spring festival). The results are updated on our website so riders can all see where they are standing throughout the year.

However there are now additional points available to allow more members to obtain points.

The second set of points is based on the % score (similar to EA point allocation). Eg. first place (for AHDC members only) with 65% would get 6 points for the place and another 3 points for their score = 9 points in total.

Between 60% to 61.999% 1 point
 Between 62% to 63.999% 2 points
 Between 64% to 65.999% 3 points
 Between 66% to 67.999% 4 points
 Between 68% to 69.999% 5 points
 Between 70% to 71.999% 6 points
 72% and over 7 points

Wow - we pulled it off!

Our Jackpot Bonanza HOTY competition on March 17 was a huge success: eight weeks from conception to completion (full credit to Sam Coleshill for coming up with the idea).

- Molly Ellis produced our E-program and our A5 paper-based program.

Arena hire days are proving to be very popular. We have several of these scheduled throughout the year, so keep an eye on Nominate and book early, as they have been selling out quickly.

Car Boot Sale -February 2nd, 2024

The weather was mild, the sales were hot! There were bargains aplenty, with everyone delighted with their purchases.

I personally sold a saddle several weeks after this event to a person in Victoria - they had seen the MCDC Facebook post and that gave them confidence to approach me- she had researched MCDC, viewed our website etc.

Our next Car Boot Sale is on Saturday May 11- there's time to start sorting out your unwanted gear, so that it may become someone else's treasure (entries will be on Nominate)

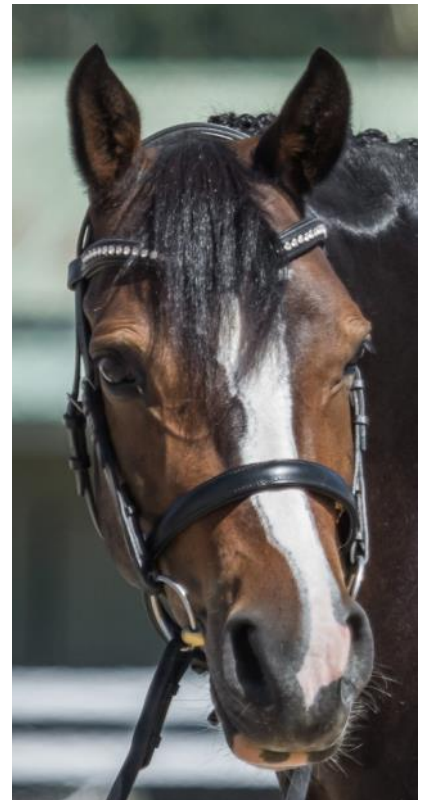

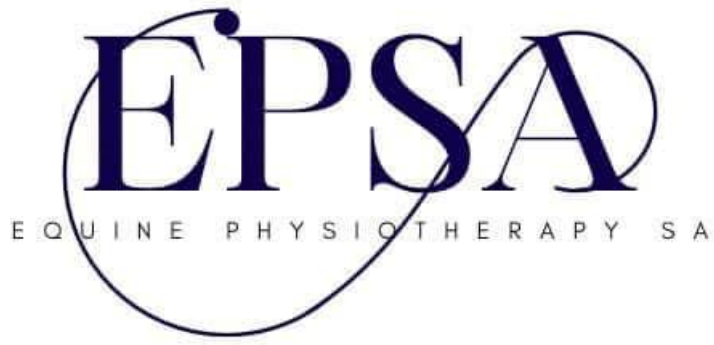
