NEWS:

BOOK FAIR: Thank you to our Librarian Jessica Klasko for organizing the Scholastic Book Fair, and to all the volunteers who helped out. Thanks to your support, we made over \$6,000 in sales, of which the school gets 50% to purchase books and resources through Scholastic for the library and classrooms. 60+ books were donated to classrooms and to Books for Belize.

STANDARDIZED TESTING: Next week, grades 1-8 will take baseline standardized testing using <u>MAP (Measures of Academic Progress)</u> computerized adaptive assessment, which measures students' knowledge in four main areas: reading, language use, math, and for some grades, general sciences. The test uses a variety of question types, such as multiple choice, fill in the blank, and drag and drop answers. Parents will receive a printout of their child's scores when testing is complete. This testing will take place again in mid-year (January) and at the end of the year (May).
