Brown Patch and Dollar Spot Summer Lawn Disease

Brown patch is really a summer lawn disease that's **caused** by a **fungus** called Rhizoctonia. The disease begins to show growth when temperatures reach 65°, but the most active growth of **brown patch** lawn disease occurs at temperatures of 80-85° when humidity levels are very high.



Dollar spot is caused by the fungal pathogen Sclerotinia homoeocarpa, in the Sclerotiniaceae family. The pathogen blights leaf tissues but does not affect turf grass roots or crowns. The disease is a common concern on golf course turf, but is rare in sports turf and professional landscapes.






