Revision of the Proposed New Class of Membership: Legacy Member D. Class 4 Legacy Membership: At the age of 21 a Legacy Membership can be proposed for an individual whose parent or guardian is a member in good standing. The first year's membership of the proposed Legacy member will be free of charge with no initiation fee. The following conditions apply: Application must be filled out to provide or update sponsoring member's information and the application must have approval of the Board, then proposed to the membership for approval.

Application process should begin two months prior to birthday month as the membership procedure takes 60 days, therefore, it would be completed by the 21<sup>st</sup> birthday. If Legacy's birthday is late in the year, the application process should begin in August, therefore the legacy year will carry through the following calendar year. The Legacy membership card will be significantly different from general membership to show Legacy membership distinction. The Legacy year is considered the first year of membership and will count toward tenure if followed by continuous annual membership fee renewal. This will be voted on at the August 1<sup>st</sup> Membership Meeting.

We will be placing signs on the proberty stating non-members will be towed at their expense so please remember when you launch your boat or watercraft to place your sticker on the driver's side of your trailer so you will not be towed.
