UPCOMING Speaker—You Don't Want To Miss This!

Christian Hartsock is a Chief Investigative Reporter for Project Veritas. His undercover infiltration of Hillary Clinton's dirty tricks operatives plotting violence at Trump rallies was the #1 trending political video on YouTube, earned front-page coverage in The New York Times twice on opening week, primetime coverage on CNN, MSNBC and FOX News, mentions by Donald Trump in the third debate, begrudging responses from Obama White House and Hillary Clinton herself and the resignations and terminations of Clinton advisor Robert Creamer and Scott Foval.



Hartsock's later infiltrations into CNN exposed Van Jones admitting to Hartsock that Russiagate was a "nothingburger" (prompting a damage control segment on AC360 as well as a grassroots T-shirt franchise), an ABC correspondent admitting his network was fake news (prompting his suspension and reassignment), and a high-level Google executive confiding plans for algorithmic manipulation of the 2020 election in (prompting outcries from President Trump, interrogations of Google executives by Ted Cruz on the Senate and House floors and YouTube video ban). Hartsock has also made headlines confronting New York Times executive editor Dean Baquet, Washington Post reporter Dave Weigel and Facebook's Head of Integrity Guy Rosen, earning Project Veritas a permanent ban from Twitter.

Hartsock was hired by his friend and mentor Andrew Breitbart as an editor for Breitbart News and contributor to BigJournalism under Dana Loesch, where he broke national headlines with his undercover videos eliciting calls for the lynching of Clarence Thomas by racist Common Cause activists and fraudulent "sick notes" from activist doctors in the Occupy Madison protest (prompting an investigation by the UW Medical Board), and signatures petitioning a ban on water at a U.N. Climate Summit.

Born and raised in Oakland, California, Hartsock currently resides in Los Angeles. He earned his B.A. in Film and Video Production from Brooks Institute in Santa Barbara and went on to direct a music video for Guns N Roses' Chinese Democracy tour and produce an award-winning independent feature film, has since written and directed an internationally televised short film, a parody infomercial starring Gavin McInnes and multiple music videos featuring O'Keefe, and is in development on multiple narrative features with his producer Murray Mile.
